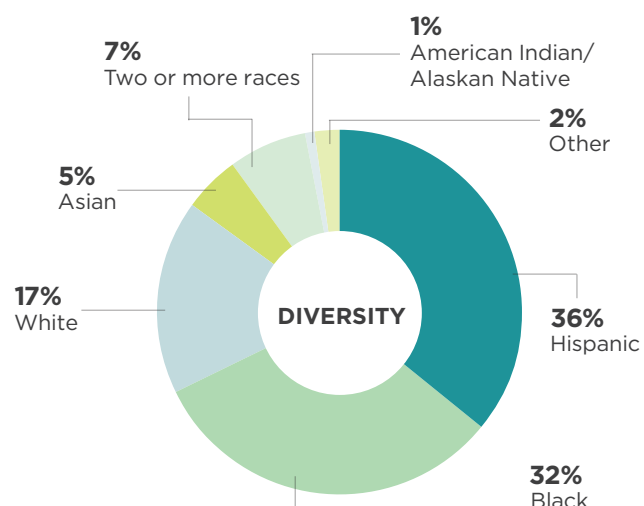

ENROLLMENT BY PROGRAM

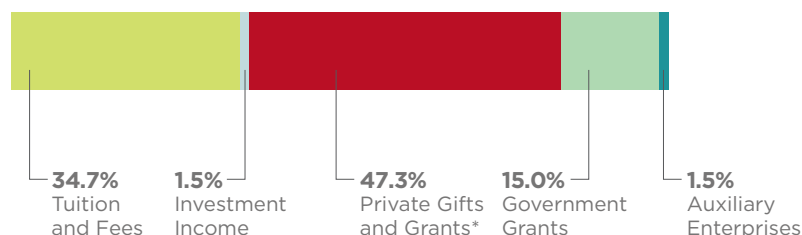

For the second year in a row, Donnelly College has been named the most diverse college in the Midwest by U.S. News & World Report.

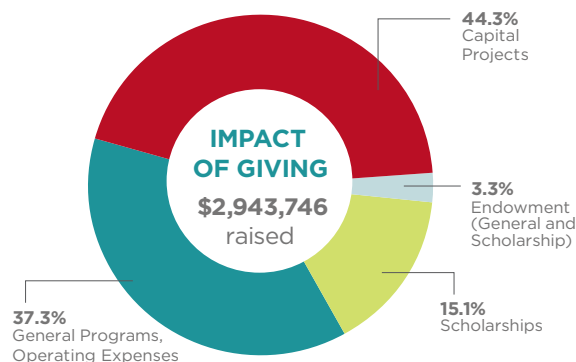
ANNUAL GIVING TO DONNELLY COLLEGE

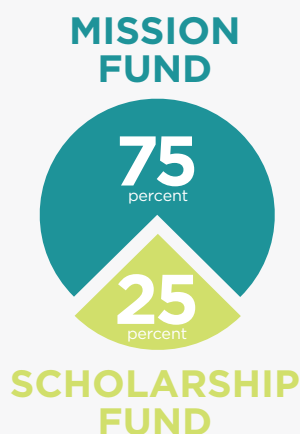

MISSION FUND

In order to keep higher education as affordable as possible, Donnelly keeps tuition as low as possible. However, this means that tuition revenue doesn't cover the full cost of running our programs. While no one is excited to pay a heating bill, utilities and general operating expenses are a very real cost for any organization. Donnelly must raise over \$1 million each year to cover costs associated with our facilities, student instruction and support services, campus safety programs, campus ministry and all other experiences that are required to educate more than 400 students annually.

SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Even with low rates, many Donnelly students cannot afford annual tuition. This is where you come in! Donnelly raises and then distributes over \$350,000 in financial aid each year because we believe that everyone has the right to learn.
